We visit and review each facility that we use.

We offer out of county and out of state placement.

Develop a proposal for treatment.

Appear in court if necessary.

Transport the client to and from the facility.

Respond to family concerns and questions.

We apply to the chosen recovery program on behalf of the defendant.

We assist with the “timing” of the court date as well as the admission to the treatment facility.

### PRIOR TO PLACEMENT, WE CONSIDER:

- What is the Dimension of the Disease?
- Do they need long term residential treatment?
- Is an intensive out patient program sufficient?
- Does the client need a sober living home?
- Does the individual have mental health issues?
- Should the program include anger management or parenting skills.
- Is the client employed, or in school?
- Are family or minor children involved?

The American Medical Association (AMA) recognizes that addiction is a disease. Too many defendants whose core problem is alcohol or substance abuse are mistakenly placed in prisons and jails. Incarceration does not change an offenders addicting behavior. Treatment can and does.
